## Lewiston Expands Route Times in January !!



### WINTER NEWS

We here at Lewiston Transit were very happy to announce our extended hours beginning in January 2014! The West Route now begins at the Lewiston Mall at 6:20 and both East and West Routes end at 7:00P.M. The Blue Line from Clarkston also runs until 7:00P.M. We had made a few changes to the West Route earlier in the year by going East on Warner to the Thain Chevron and using 6th Ave off of 9th St instead of 5th Ave. With

our new updates on the Routes we have created more transfer points to make it more convenient for our passengers to get between downtown up into the Orchards. We have also been adding a lot of information to our website, including this Newsletter that will be put out quarterly to keep our riders up to date with what we are doing at Lewiston Transit System. We meet up with the Blue Line from the Asotin County PTBA and the Appaloosa Express at the Community Center where it is free to transfer between each system. All of us have bicycle racks (first come –first serve).
