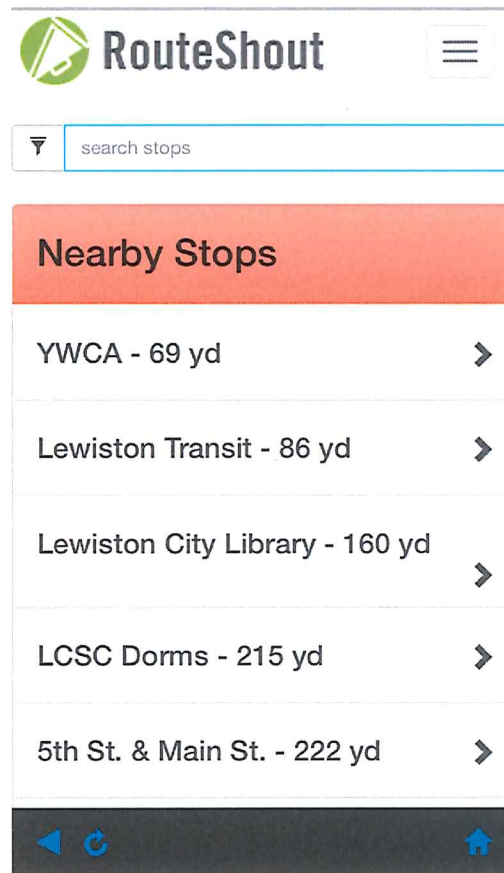
For this example:

3. I chose the YWCA, the bus is 19 minutes away!

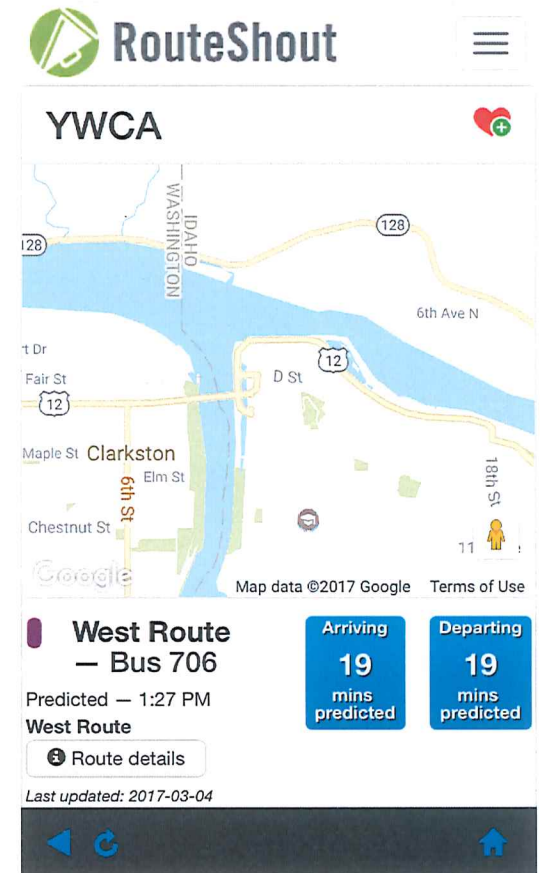

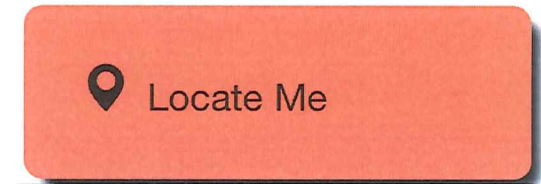

Helpful hint: To move your location around you have to use two fingers on the map.

If you have issues with the “Locate me” button, here are some troubleshooting tips -



When Using RouteShout 2.0 for iOS (Apple)

Turn on Wi-Fi to help improve accuracy. Go to Settings > Wi-Fi. Or make sure that your Data is on if WiFi isn't available.

Allow RouteShout 2.0 to access your location while you use the app. To do this, click Allow on the pop-up menu that appears after you tap the Locate Me button.

Enable location services for RouteShout 2.0. Go to Settings > RouteShout 2.0 > Location. Then select While Using.

If the fixes above do not work, try resetting your location services. To do this, go to Settings > General > Reset > Reset Location & Privacy

When Using RouteShout 2.0 for Android

Turn on Wi-Fi to help improve accuracy or make sure your Data is on. You can do this from the Android top menu.

Allow RouteShout 2.0 to access your location information when you download it from the Google Play store.

Enable Location by tapping it in the top menu, or by going to Settings > More > Location. Then swipe Location to On.

When Using a Desktop Browser

If you are using RouteShout 2.0 “Locate me” on a desktop web browser, be sure to allow RouteShout 2.0 to know your location.
