Time indicated on the map reflects the earliest departure from each stop.

## Stop Times

The stop times on the map show the approximate time the bus goes by that location.

## Flag Stops

To request a flag stop, you must be in a safe, visible location with enough space for the driver to safely pull over and for other vehicles to see you. Let the driver know your intentions by extending your arm and waving up and down. If it is dark outside, please use a flashlight or a reflector to ensure the driver sees you. Please have your fare ready when you board the bus.

## **Travel Training**

Travel Training is one-on-one personalized training in the use of public transportation. This free program provides potential riders with more in-depth instruction on how to ride public transportation and is tailored to the needs of each individual. have obtained a Half Fare Card and applies to cash fares at the time of boarding only and is available all day.


